

Computers & Industrial Engineering Special Issue on Project Management

Aims:

The Computer and Industrial Engineering Journal seeks submissions for a special issue on Project Management. The special issue will include enhanced versions of papers presented at the 16th International Conference on Project Management and Scheduling, held in Rome, Italy during April 17-20, 2018. High-quality papers are sought from conference participants, but submissions are also welcome from anyone who wants to submit novel theoretical or applied contributions within this area. Papers should employ a rigorous research methodology and should have relevance and practicable implications.

Scope:

Topics to be covered include, but are not restricted to, the following aspects of Project Management: Network modeling, Project scheduling, Resource management, Due-date management, Project risk management, Project scheduling under uncertainty, Proactive/reactive project scheduling, Multicriteria project scheduling, Applications.

Submission Guidelines:

All papers must be original and have not published, submitted and/or are currently under review elsewhere. Manuscripts should be submitted through the publisher's online system, Elsevier Editorial System (EES) at http://ees.elsevier.com/caie/. Please follow the instructions described in the "Guide for Authors", given on the main page of EES website. Please make sure you select "Special Issue" as Article Type and "Project Management" as Section/Category. In preparing their manuscript, authors are asked to closely follow the "Instructions to Authors". Submissions will be reviewed according to C&IE's rigorous standards and procedures through double-blind peer review by at least two qualified reviewers. Accepted papers become the property of C&IE's publisher, Elsevier.
