THEMES AND SCOPE

PMS 2018 (16th International Conference on Project Management and Scheduling) is organized by the Department of Enterprise Engineering of the University of Rome “Tor Vergata” (Rome, Italy). PMS is an international conference series (held every two years in different locations in Europe) initialized by the EURO PMS Working Group, devoted to project management and scheduling.
